You MUST provide proof of insurance, which MUST be valid during the date(s) of the event, and a copy of a valid driver's license with this application for the person driving a vehicle in the parade. If you are unsure who will be driving, provide copies of all possible drivers' licenses and insurance.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: RETURN YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION BY JULY 31st. Units will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. CaribFest Parade Committee MAKES NO PROMISES AS TO THE POSITION OF YOUR UNIT IN THE PARADE AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE POSITIONS AS NECESSARY.

SAFETY: The "Parade of Cultures" Committee and the Norfolk Police Department ask that you PLEASE REFRAIN FROM THROWING CANDY, TRINKETS, ETC. TO ANYONE ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. This can be very dangerous due to the motor vehicles in the parade. **You may have "walkers**" along the side of the parade route handing out these items.

NOTE: In order to make the parade a success we are asking all participates to follow some simple rules that will be provided later.
